Compostable household waste

Food scraps, eggshells and small bones are to be placed in a paper bag and then put in the brown container. Add kitchen paper or place a sheet of newspaper in the bottom if it gets too wet.

Sorted waste

Combustible household waste

Collect the combustible household waste in an optional bag and place it in the green container.

E.g. envelopes, all plastic that is not packaging, vacuum cleaner bags, diapers, cottons, snuff and gum.



To be taken to the recycling station

Clear glass containers

Only jars and bottles!

Note: Returnable bottles are to be taken back to the shop.

Light bulbs are electrical waste



Coloured glass packaging

Only jars and bottles!

Note: Not drinking glasses, mirror glass or windows.



Metal packaging

If it is a tube, empty as much out as possible, and then leave the cap in place.



Plastic packaging

Recycle both rigid and non-rigid plastic. Place them loosely in the same container for subsequent mechanical separation.



Paper packaging

Recycle both cartons and bags.

Rinse out, flatten and fold up the packaging!



Newspapers and printed material

Include books with soft covers and note pads with spiral backs. Note: No envelopes and post-it notes.



To be taken to the recycling central Långskogen

Electrical waste

Anything powered by a cord or battery.

E.g. consumer electronics, lowenergy bulbs, fluorescent tubes, watches, telephones, chargers, toys.



Hazardous waste

Paint residues, batteries, solvents, varnish, adhesive, oil residues, asbestos, chemicals, spray cans, materials containing mercury.

Seal the container tightly and mark it with the contents or write "unknown" if you don't know. Do not mix different types of waste.



Landfill

Everything that cannot be incinerated or recycled.

E.g. porcelain, ceramics, fuses, plugs, clay pots, plaster.



Reuse

Everything that someone else can benefit.

Reuse to Fenix Second-hand shop.

Construction reuse, individuals can give or get what they wish.

Leisure things to Fritidsbanken.

Clothes to charity.



Combustible Bulky waste

Only bulky waste, not ordinary household waste.

E.g. furniture, large toys, mattresses, skis etc.

Furniture with springs

Sofas and elastic mattresses with springs.

Garden waste

E.g. grass, moss, leaves, thicket. Note: No stocks, stones, larger twigs or plastic bags.



Corrugated cardboard

Distinguished by its corrugated layer. Small amounts can be left at the recycling station.



Scrap-metal

All metal that is not packaging.

E.g. saucepans, tools, bicycles, guttering, drainpipes, rims. Rims with tires are sorted separately.



Wood waste

Sorted into fractions: pressure impregnated, pallets, pallet collars and other wood waste.



Appliances

Refrigerators, cookers, washing machines etc. Sorted into two fractions; with or without refrigerant.

Tires

Are sorted divided in two fractions; with or without rim.

Plane glass

Windows, car windows, mirrors and drinking glasses.
